THE NUTCRACKER - SATURDAY 13TH & 14TH APRIL

WHERE TO GO..... KINGSWOOD SCHOOL, LANSDOWN, BATH, BA1 5RG - A MAP CAN BE FOUND ON OUR WEBSITE

The theatre entrance is off **FONTHILL ROAD** (first left <u>AFTER</u> the school as you travel <u>UP</u> LANSDOWN ROAD) where there is parking space along FONTHILL ROAD. This is a **ONE WAY** system, so to return to LANSDOWN ROAD you need to travel along FONTHILL ROAD and turn left onto COLLEGE ROAD, then left again (HAMILTON ROAD) back to LANSDOWN ROAD (this loop runs around the school grounds and these roads also offer parking)

STUDENTS TO BE DELIVERED TO THE THEATRE ENTRANCE WHERE SIGNS WILL DIRECT THEM TO THE RELEVANT ROOMS.

WHAT TIME – Please look at the **AMENDED** timetable below and the cast list to see your child's start and finish times.

CAN PARENTS STAY – No, only Pre-school parents can stay with their child. Each group will have 2/3 CRB checked volunteers to look after and get a group ready for each performance.

WILL A PACKED LUNCH BE NEEDED? Yes, Pre-Primary, Primary and Grade 1B have only one performance but will need a lunch box as they have a rehearsal before. Everyone else will need food for the day and a water bottle. Pre-schoolers will need some snacks. **No Eating or Drinking in Costumes.**

WHAT ELSE TO BRING - Dance kit for the rehearsal as costumes will not be worn until the performances. Dressing Gown can be worn while makeup and hair is being done. All ballet girl students need pink ballet tights, and cleaned or new pink ballet shoes. They can be machine washed but do shrink a little although often stretch back after the first wearing. Boys will need their own cleaned white ballet shoes. Underwear must be white or nude for all students and older girls will need a nude multi way bra for some costumes. Tap students will need their own tap shoes. SOMETHING TO DO EG: BOOK, GAME, COLOURING, DS.......

EVERYTHING MUST BE NAMED.

HAIR - Hair grips, pins, hair elastics, hairnets and named hair brush. Details for groups on cast lists.

MAKEUP (not Pre-school or Pre-Primary) - Makeup base for, (medium shade) and mascara. (We will provide lipstick, eye shadow and blusher) - PLEASE INFORM US OF ANY SKIN ALLERGIES.

COSTUMES – WILL BE PREPARED FOR ALL AND MUST BE TREATED WITH RESPECT AND FOLDED AND HUNG AFTER EACH PERFORMANCE. PLEASE INFORM THE GROUP LEADER IF A COSTUME OR ACCESSORY IS BROKEN.
