## What's it all about?

### Bringing new opportunities to dedicated dancers.

Initially, this will entail classes in particular dance or choreographic styles, as well as creative skills.

We will always be making work for new platforms and will have additional pieces in our own productions.

We will also generate leadership experiences for participants to work in outreach settings, and with younger dancers.

## What is the cost?

The lessons are £6.50 each charged per term. This added to your termly invoice.

There may be additional charges for external tuition, costume, uniform, travel etc. We will keep you informed with good notice of these. We would expect PBS Dance Company members to participate in additional opportunities wherever possible.

## Who can audition?

Any dedicated dancer aged 13+ who would like to pursue more opportunities. We are looking for choreographers as well as performers! You'll get the chance to do both, but the balance will be based on your strengths and your preference. We will offer additional auditions slots later in the year for those who are turning 13 and show the attitude and aptitude we are looking for.

## How do I audition?

1. Request an audition slot by email to [lucy@elmdance.com](mailto:lucy@elmdance.com) You will be sent an audition time on 26<sup>th</sup> June or 3<sup>rd</sup> July. You will also be sent more detail about audition requirements and an application form.
2. Your audition will involve a timed choreographic task (you don't need to prepare for this) and a short solo or duet performance. Your performance can be in any genre.
3. Complete the form and bring it to your audition slot.

## How do the selections get made?

Any dancer who impresses us in audition will be considered as a Dancer, Choreographer or both. We may also consider attendance and attitude shown in current classes. Unsuccessful applicants will be given clear, constructive feedback and encouragement - to improve their chances of success in the future.
